Present :


Matthew Sharp through his attorney, John H. Musser; and St. Tammany Marine and Powersports through their attorney, J. Douglas Sunseri.

Considering the evidence as a whole, the Court considers as follows:

IT IS ORDERED, AJUDGED AND DECREED that the employer, St. Tammany Marine & Powersports miscalculated employee's indemnity benefits for a total underpayment of \$143.46. Consequently, the Court awards Matthew C. Sharp \$550.00 in attorney fees against St. Tammany Marine and Powersports.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, AJUDGED AND DECREED that any other missteps by the adjuster regarding timely payment of medical payments or failure to timely supply requested information was not done so maliciously, arbitrarily nor capriciously. Thus all other claims for penalty and attorney fees are denied.
